Summer Stock & Summer Theater Workshop

Completed
Grades 3-12

Open to all students who have completed Grades 3 through 12.

NEW THIS YEAR - THEATER WORKSHOP



Theater Workshop only
Completed grades 3-5.

Students who have completed grades 3-5 will participate in a Theater Workshop Program, *Alice In Wonderland, Jr.*, that will run alongside the traditional Summer Stock Program. Additionally they will join the Summer Stock Program for a few scenes and Company Dance Numbers. Rehearsals will begin

on **July 6th** and culminate with 2 performances on Friday, **July 29** and Saturday, **July 30** at 11 am.

Students who have completed grades 6-12 will continue to participate in the traditional Summer Stock Program. Auditions for lead roles in *Footloose* will occur on Monday and Tuesday, June 27 & 28, any needed callback auditions will be held later in the week. Audition materials will be available via the NSD website beginning June 1st.

Regular rehearsals for the entire cast & the Theater workshop will begin on **Tuesday, July 6** and end with performances **Wednesday, July 27 through Saturday, July 30**.

Art Workshop

Completed
Grades K-12

The Art Program is open to all students who have completed Kindergarten through Grade 12. Each student will receive a two hour group lesson each day, based on their grade level, Tuesday through Thursday.



Completed Grades K-5 from 8-10 am. Art instruction may include sculpture, crafts, drawing, painting, printmaking, and sketching.

Completed Grades 6-12 from 10:30-12:30 pm. This program will encompass digital art using the computer as an artist's tool. Students' experience may include digital imaging with PhotoShop, film making with Animoto, and animation using a variety of software.

Classes begin on **Tuesday, July 6th** and end on **Thursday, July 29th** with an art show.

Instrumental Lessons & Ensembles

Completed
Grades 3-12

Instrumental music instruction includes string, percussion, and wind instruments. Large and small ensembles will be formed based on student enrollment, ability and experience.

Open to all students entering Grade 3 through Grade 12 for strings and Grade 4 through Grade 12 for winds and percussion.

Two group lessons each week lasting one half hour each, Monday through Thursday.

All lessons will be scheduled between 8:00 AM and 12:00 noon. Ensemble rehearsal times will be determined based on enrollment.



Lessons begin on **Tuesday, July 6** and end with a concert on **Thursday, July 29**.

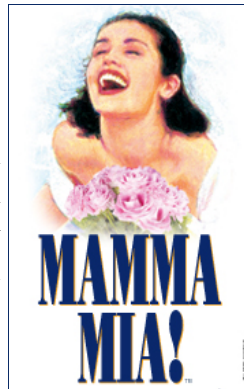
