## Free and Reduced Meals Program


Your child may be eligible for the Free and Reduced Meals Program. The program provides breakfast and lunch for a reduced price or for free, based on your income. The program is confidential. Children eligible for the program receive a meal card that is the same meal card full-paying students receive. There is no difference.

The chart below shows the Income Eligibility Guidelines used to determine if a child is eligible for free or reduced breakfast and lunch at school. If your annual income is at or below the amount in the second column for the number of people in your household listed in the first column, your child may be eligible for REDUCED meals. If your annual income is below the amount in the  $7^{th}$  column for the number of people in your household listed in the first column, your child may be eligible for FREE meals.

To Apply for Free and Reduce Lunch,

1. Go to the Neshaminy Website at www.neshaminy.org and click on "School Lunches."



2. Scroll down to Free/Reduced Meals, click on "HERE."

<u>Lunch</u> - Students are offered 5 components and must take 3 - one must be a fruit or veggie. Components offered: 1. Meat/Meat Alternate 2. Bread/Grain, 3. Fruit 4. Vegetable 5. Milk.

**Note**: Some Entrees include 2 components (M/MA and B/G) such as Pizza, Burgers, Sandwiches, Breakfast Sandwich, Mini Pancakes, etc. When an entree consists of 2 components, the student only has to take a fruit or veggie with the entree - but of course may take all components offered.

## **Payment Procedures**

Neshaminy uses ParentOnline for payments. You will need to register at <a href="http://www.ParentOnline.net">http://www.ParentOnline.net</a> to see balances, choose restrictions, etc. at no cost - but the deposit fee is 5% should you choose to use it. You'll need your child's student ID number which you can find on the report card mailed home last year, by asking your child the number they use to log onto Neshaminy computers, or call your school for the number.

Payme an also be sent to school by cash, check, or money order. Neshaminy School District ever call your home and ask you for credit card information.
