Call to Order

Mr. Congdon called the meeting to order at 7:11 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Congdon requested those in attendance join in the salute to the flag.

Announcements

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Copeland advised the Board on the following:

Approval of request for Sunday Field Usage by the Bucks County Challenge Mustangs Flag Football.

Mr. Congdon made a motion to approve Sunday Field Usage for the Bucks County Challenge Mustangs Flag Football.

Mr. Allen seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved said motion by a vote of 9 ayes, and 0 nays.

Reynolds ESCO project update.

Mr. Spar gave a Power Point presentation on the Reynolds ESCO project.

Mr. Rudy made a motion to do a feasibility study to make an addition to Oliver Heckman to a 900 student capacity.

Mr. Morris seconded the motion.

Mr. Congdon called for a roll call vote and the tally indicated the motion failed by a vote of 7 nays, (Mr. Allen, Ms. Boyle, Mr. Congdon, Mrs. Cummings, Mr. Pirritano, Mr. Shubin, and Mr. Sposato) and 2 ayes, (Mr. Rudy and Mr. Morris.)

Public Comment

Margie McCurdy, Poquessing Elementary School instructional assistant, resident of Trevose, spoke of the duties of the support staff and how they go above and beyond their duties to benefit the students. Ms. McCurdy stated that the students and district will not get the same caring support staff employees if they outsource the positions.

Ed Kern, retired, resident of Levittown, stated that he feels the timing of the vote to extend the contract and award a raise to the superintendent was ill advised since the support staff is facing a possible elimination of their positions. He also said that, as a member of the advisory committee for the consolidation project, he feels the decision should be put to a referendum and let the taxpayers have a vote in the matter.

Angle Manning, New Jersey teacher, resident of Middletown Township, remarked that the citizen's advisory committee only had two options to vote on for the consolidation project. Ms. Manning stated that as the plan now stands one third of the district will be cut out.

Steve Rodos, retired, resident of Villages of Flowers Mill, mentioned that the McKissick Group was not terminated because of inferior work. Mr. Rodos also wanted it clarified that the Board has not misled taxpayers regarding the possible increase in future taxes. He also stated that he has researched the affect of property values regarding closed or abandoned schools and the answers vary depending on the particular study.

Judi Keenan, Lower Southampton Elementary School instructional assistant, resident of Langhorne, said the support staff personnel love their jobs and do them well. She testified how much loving feedback the support staff gets from the school students who appreciate the special attention that they receive.

David Kroeger, Neshaminy bus driver, said if the bus drivers are outsourced it will cause discontent throughout the district. He urged the Board to reconsider outsourcing.

Mindy Anderson, President of NESPA, resident of Levittown, said the support staff has always been willing to work with the district in all matters of collective bargaining and they are just looking for a fair deal. She said the goal is to have a great school district for the children.

John McGinley, Vice President of NESPA, resident of Bensalem, asked the Board to reconsider the agreement with STA of Pennsylvania for the position of Fleet Maintenance Supervisor. He stated that the position was not posted internally. He asked the Board how they can bargain in good faith when they have not given the proper opportunities to employees within the district to advance.

Mary Thornton, Neshaminy instructional assistant, resident of Langhorne, reviewed the duties of the instructional assistants and the importance of their positions.

Approval of Minutes

Mrs. Burns presented the minutes of June 17, June 26, and August 5, 2014. Upon motion of Mr. Congdon and seconded by Mr. Pirritano the Board unanimously approved the minutes of the June 17, June 26, and August 5, 2014 Board Meeting Minutes.

Motion: Approval of Agreement with STA of Pennsylvania, Inc.

Mr. Congdon presented the following motion:

WHEREAS, The Neshaminy School District is entering into an agreement with STA of Pennsylvania, Inc. to retain a Full Time Fleet Maintenance Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said agreement will be to reduce significantly the overhead, insurance and operating expenses expected to be incurred by the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Neshaminy Board of School Directors approves the agreement with STA of Pennsylvania, Inc. in the form submitted as approved by the Solicitor and Superintendent of Schools.

Mr. Shubin seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved said motion by a vote of 9 ayes, and 0 nays.

Motion: Approval of Full Day Kindergarten for the 2014 - 2015 School Year

Mr. Congdon presented the following motion:

WHEREAS, the District conducted a full-year kindergarten pilot program for the 2013 – 2014 school year; and

WHEREAS, the District has witnessed more significant academic growth for the full day kindergarten students versus half day kindergarten students; and

WHEREAS, the District is committed to early childhood education; and

WHEREAS, the District has committed funding from the budget for full day kindergarten.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Neshaminy Board of School Directors approves full day kindergarten starting in the 2014 – 2015 school year.

Mr. Morris seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved said motion by a vote of 9 ayes, and 0 nays.

Motion: Approval of S4 Teachers LLC

Mr. Profy presented the following motion:

NESHAMINY SCHOOL DISTRICT SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS PLACEMENT AGREEMENT

S4TEACHERS LLC

WHEREAS, the District had a Substitute Teachers Service Contract with S4 Teachers LLC dba source for Substitute Teachers for 2013-2014 School Year; and

WHEREAS, the District through the Superintendent has negotiated an one (1) year extension of the Contract upon terms and conditions favorable to the District; and

WHEREAS, only non-substantive provisions of the Contract remain to be clarified and the District needs Substitute Teachers for the 2014-2015 School Year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Neshaminy Board of School Directors approves of the Contract and authorizes the execution of the Contract by Officers of the School District upon approval of the Contract by Superintendent and Solicitor of the District.

Mr. Shubin seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved said motion by a vote of 9 ayes, and 0 nays.

Mrs. Markowitz advised the Board that the total amount of Federal Grants is \$16,300.

Public Comment

Danielle Foster, Neshaminy bus driver, said that she loves her job. Ms. Foster voiced her disapproval of Neshaminy utilizing Source4Teachers.

Angie Manning, New Jersey teacher, resident of Middletown, said outsourced bus drivers do not get the support that Neshaminy drivers get. She urged the Board not to outsource the bus drivers.

Public Board Meeting Minutes of the Neshaminy Board of School Directors (cont.) August 26, 2014

Steve Rodos, retired, resident of Villages of Flowers Mills, thanked the Board and Mr. Copeland for full-day kindergarten. He explained that several years ago he disapproved of closing elementary schools because at that time it was not financially practical. Mr. Rodos also remarked that the size of schools depends on many factors, such as the staff, aides, etc.

Pat Delassandro, Neshaminy employee, urged the Board to have a referendum so the taxpayers can decide on the consolidation matter.

Gene Zahn, editor, resident of Langhorne Borough, commented that there are students that are walkers that attend Oliver Heckman Elementary School. He also questioned whether the current traffic issues due to bridge construction have been taken into consideration in the consolidation project. Mr. Zahn posed several inquiries to the Board regarding decisions that have been made regarding the consolidation project.

Mary Thornton, instructional assistant, resident of Langhorne, stated that the students and the teachers need the instructional assistants and they are an important part of the educational process.

Board Comment

Mr. Shubin thanked the administration and the support staff for a good job in preparing for the school year. He stated that there are many positive plans in place for Neshaminy. Mr. Shubin commented that the issue of underperforming teachers in the classroom is an important one and must be dealt with. He said that he is excited to see what the new school year will bring to Neshaminy.

Mr. Morris thanked Mr. Copeland for coordinating the plan for the district over the summer and for getting full-day kindergarten up and running.

Mr. Pirritano thanked everyone for attending the meeting and announced that an Ad Hoc/Facilities Committee meeting will be held on September 17th at 7 p.m. Mr. Pirritano said there is no issue expected with the bridge construction during the Tawanka project. He said other financial and facilities questions can be answered on the district blog site. He thanked the teachers and staff for preparing for the school year.

Mr. Sposato clarified that the savings due to consolidation will be approximately \$2 million per year. He reiterated that the goal is to work out an equitable solution for everyone.

<u>Adjournment</u>

Mr. Congdon moved the meeting be adjourned and Mr. Allen seconded the motion. The Board unanimously approved the motion. Mr. Congdon adjourned the meeting at 8:51 p.m.
