During that time, despite the challenge, Mason diligently pursued his studies and was recognized on the Honor Roll; he also participated in community service.

Mason was a great friend, gifted student, school ambassador, student leader, musician, football player, and ardent Eagles fan. Most importantly, he was a thoughtful, generous and compassionate individual. He sought out the child who was sad, lonely, discouraged, or hungry and would give them anything he had to make them feel better. It is this legacy the foundation was created to carry on.
