21		teacher(s)/Advisor(s). Once initiated, the teacher(s)/Advisor(s) may	
22		discontinue using Social Media. If a School District sponsored Social Media site or account is discontinued, it must be taken down to the	
23		extent possible.

12		i. The teacher(s)/Advisor(s) may have students assist in the review and	12
12		deletion of inappropriate material from School District sponsored	13
13 14		Social Media sites or accounts, provided, however, that this function	13 14
14 15		is part of the educational function and is reviewed and monitored	14
15 16		by the teacher(s)/Advisor(s). The teacher(s)/Advisor(s) is ultimately	15 16
10		responsible for ensuring that inappropriate material is not kept on any	10
17 18		School District sponsored account or site.	17
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
