

# Hoover Elementary Title 1 News

The purpose of this newsletter is explain what Title 1 is and to share important Title 1 documents reviewed and revised by Hoover Elementary parents and guardians as well as by teachers and staff last month, October 2022.

#### What is Title 1?

Title I, Part A (Title I) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act provides financial assistance to school districts and schools with high percentages of children from families that have economic disadvantages. The federal funding is used to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards. Federal funds are currently allocated through four statutory formulas that are based primarily on census poverty estimates and the cost of education in each state. Title I is the largest of the federally funded education programs.

Hoover Elementary School is a Schoolwide Title I school. Our Title I funds and services can provide strategies for improving the entire school so that every student achieves high levels of academic proficiency. Below are some of the benefits to being a Schoolwide Title I school:

- · All students may participate in Title I funded initiatives
- · Maximizes flexibility in using Federal funds
- Serves as a vehicle for whole-school reform with focus on improving achievement of lowestachieving students.
- Addresses student needs through a Schoolwide plan based on a comprehensive needs assessment.

#### **How Parents and Families Can Get Involved in Title 1**

Parents are notified about Title I services and encouraged to participate in school activities/meetings. Families may participate in informational meetings and learning opportunities throughout the school year. Parents are provided information via newsletters, conferences, school web pages, meetings and workshops.
