### It's simple and rewarding.

- **Personalized Placement**—JA works with you and your schedule to ensure you teach at the location and grade level of your choice. JA of SEPA reaches eight counties in the area, so you'll have a variety of schools to choose from.
- **Comprehensive Training**—JA staff provides training so you are comfortable visiting the classroom. This includes webinars, in person training, as well as videos you can watch on your own time. You will be trained in classroom management, understanding and relaying the JA curriculum, working with the classroom teacher, and communicating effectively with students.
- **Flexible Time Commitment**—Most programs take place during the school day, but some occur in after-school settings. Depending on your program choice and delivery method (traditional or JA in a Day), class time can vary from 30 or 55 minutes for several weeks, to 4-5 hours in one day.
- **JA Staff Follow-Up and Support**—JA staff is available to answer questions or make suggestions pertaining to your volunteer assignment, whenever you need it.

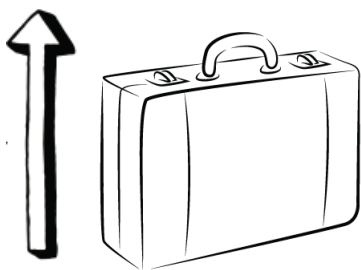
