

Library Book Care

Please help your child keep their library books safe at home. In class we have discussed keeping books away from pets, young children, food, and drinks.

One of the most common causes of library book damage is a leaking water bottle in their backpack. Please encourage students to keep their water bottles in their lunch box or an outer pocket of their backpack.

If a book is damaged, please do not try to fix it on your own. We have special tape and glue made specifically for this use in the library. Students should return their books with a "book hospital" slip inside.

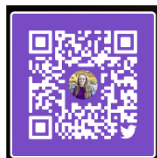

What do students learn in the library?

The Neshaminy library curriculum focuses on information literacy skills. Students will learn to find reliable information sources and share what they have learned with classmates.

Using iPads and Chromebooks, students will develop strong technology and collaboration skills. Students will also learn to navigate the library to find books for information and entertainment. All of the skills practiced in the library help students become productive citizens and lifelong learners.



Borrowing Library Materials

Students in grades K-4 will borrow one or two library books at a time, depending on grade level. Books will be due back on the day of your student's library class. There are no fines for late library books, however, families are required to pay for lost or damaged materials. Please help your students to return library books on the day they are due, so other students may enjoy them. Students who do not return their books will be unable to check out a new book until the materials are returned.
