- I will have exemplary in school behavior and I will work as hard as I can to be academically eligible.
- I will be respectful and use common sense when using any and all social media. I will not post
 material on social media that defames the Neshaminy School District, softball team, coaches,
 players, or any opposing teams or players. There will be nothing posted that contains vulgar,
 obscene, or indecent language or images.

NESHAMINY SOFTBALL BOOSTER BY-LAWS

- 1. Softball boosters are unpaid parent volunteers.
- 2. The money that is collected or fundraised by the boosters is for the betterment of the softball program. The mission of the boosters is to supplement the schools operating costs and help provide the players, managers, and coaches with the things they need to compete at the highest level possible and have an enjoyable season. This includes (but is not limited to) equipment, gym time, apparel, trips, and team bonding activities.
- 3. Booster fees and monies that are fundraised are NON-REFUNDABLE. If a player chooses to leave the team or is dismissed for any reason, their booster fee or any monies fundraised in their name will not be refunded.
- 4. Paying booster fees or fundraising does not guarantee a player anything in regard to what team they are on (Varsity or JV), the position (or how many innings) they play or where (or if) they bat in the line-up.
- 5. Booster money is spent at the discretion of the Head Coach with approval from the Booster President and Treasurer or vice versa.
