Call to Order

Mr. Congdon called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Congdon requested those in attendance join in the salute to the flag.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Copeland advised the Board that the administrators will be meeting next week and the district is getting ready for a great opening to the 2014/ 2015 school year.

Public Comment

Mary Ellen Pulak, instructional assistant for Neshaminy School District, resident of Levittown, asked for a no vote against the arbitrator report. Ms. Pulak said it would be a mistake to outsource because it would be unfair to the children and the dedicated staff.

Ed Kern, retired, resident of Levittown, voiced his opposition to the proposed closing of 3 Neshaminy elementary schools. He asked the Board to consider having a referendum on the subject.

Tim Sauritch, teacher at Samuel Everitt Elementary School, implored the Board to reconsider the decision to close the 3 elementary schools and build a new super school and move fifth graders to middle school. Mr. Sauritch voiced his concern about the influence that upper grades could have on the younger fifth graders causing them to grow up too fast.

Regular Board Meeting Minutes of the Neshaminy Board of School Directors (cont.) August 5, 2014

Mike Nelson, business owner, resident of Levittown, said that children today need the best education that is possible in order to compete in a global economy. Mr. Nelson questioned whether closing elementary schools and building a new super school is the best decision. He said the money should be put into new educational programs and repairing the existing schools.

Mr. Allen seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved said motion by a vote of 9 ayes and 0 nays.

Mr. Shubin seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved said motion by a vote of 9 ayes and 0 nays.

c) Extra Curricular Staff and Salary Report

Mr. Copeland advised the Board on the Extra Curricular Staff and Salary Report. (See enclosed copy)

- Ms. Boyle seconded the motion.

The Board unanimously approved said motion by a vote of 9 ayes and 0 nays.

d) Consideration of NESPA Fact Finding Report

Mr. Congdon read a statement regarding the NESPA Fact Finding Report.

As you know, we are actively engaged in negotiating with our Support Staff, and part of that process is what is known as a Fact Finding Report. This report is provided by an independent labor lawyer from the Pennsylvania Department of Labor. The Fact Finder takes both testimony and data from both the union and the district and at the conclusion he produces a report, which outlines what he thinks should be a final settlement. We received the report on July 28th, and we scheduled this meeting because we must act in a ten day timeframe. If both parties agree, we have a contract. We cannot take pieces of the report. It must be accepted in whole or not at all. Also, the Labor Board says, the parties must not release the report. Only the Labor Board can release the report.

We have consulted with our labor solicitor, Ellis Katz, and tonight the Board will vote on the report. Please note, that we found much of what the Fact Finder reported very encouraging and we feel very good about much of his conclusions. If it is rejected by the Board this evening, it will be rejected over a few points.

We hope that with this as a starting point, we can return to the bargaining table and quickly come to a resolution. It is our understanding that the Labor Board will release the report on their website very shortly.

I would also like to take this time to thank the committee for their hard work and time commitment to this important effort. The committee, chaired by Mr. Mark Shubin and his team, Mrs. Sue Cummings and Mr. Mike Morris, I thank you for your time and effort involved.

Mr. Shubin made a motion to reject the Fact Finding Report.

Mr. Morris seconded the motion.

Mr. Congdon called for a roll call vote and the tally indicated the motion passed by a vote of 9 ayes, (Mr. Allen, Ms. Boyle, Mr. Congdon, Mrs. Cummings, Mr. Morris, Mr. Pirritano, Mr. Rudy, Mr. Shubin, and Mr. Sposato) and 0 nays.

Mr. Congdon stated that at this time the NESPA Fact Finding Report has been rejected.

Public Comment

Bob Tull requested that the budget information on the Neshaminy website be made more user friendly in order to better access the information more thoroughly.

Future Topics

Mr. Shubin suggested that the food service report be presented at a town hall forum to be presented to the public.

Mr. Copeland stated that the consultant is prepared to attend the next Finance Committee meeting to present an overview.

Board Comment

Mr. Sposato asked Mr. Morris if he can refer him to the specific sources where he obtained information that real estate values are affected in areas of school closings.

Mr. Morris said he will get the names of the realtors that support the theory. He also said that he is concerned that closing selected schools will have a negative effect on certain neighborhoods within the district, which is inequitable.

Mr. Pirritano thanked the public for attending the meeting and giving their input. He reiterated that the Board's goal is to reinvest in the community by bringing new programs and being fiscally responsible.

Adjournment

Mr. Congdon moved the meeting be adjourned and Mr. Shubin seconded the motion. The Board unanimously approved the motion. Mr. Congdon adjourned the meeting at 7:40 p.m.
