We are pleased to share your child has expressed an interest in joining **Poquessing's Reading Olympics Team**. The Bucks County Reading Olympics inspires kids to become lifelong readers. The purpose of the event is to encourage children to read more, to read a great variety of books and to enjoy the excitement of reading and discussing books. Most of the preparation for this event will consist of individual reading of books from the official list. Poquessing will participate in two divisions this year. Our **elementary team** will consist of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders. Our **middle school team** will consist of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. Competitions will be held on separate evenings. Competitions will be held the evenings of **April 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019 for Elementary** at Neshaminy High School and **April 11<sup>th</sup> 2019 for Middle School** at a local Bucks County Middle School.

The members of each team (12-15 students) will share the responsibility of reading from a selected list of 45 books and then compete as a team against other schools in Bucks County. All students involved agree to read at least five books (many students read more) from the list to remain on the team and participate in the competition. During the competition, students use their <u>collective</u> knowledge to answer questions during three rounds of testing.

Weekly meetings during W.I.N. and after school will begin in January. By March, most of the reading should be complete and we will start reviewing and studying the books. Video conference practice competitions between Maple Point and Sandburg will take place in March after school.

The success of our Reading Olympics program is dependent on each individual doing their part to contribute to the team as a whole. Students joining Reading Olympics must fulfill their commitment to read the books they select and participate in the competition. Please make sure your student understands joining Reading Olympics is a commitment to read their five books and continue with the team up to and including the competition.
