**1) Motion: Lease for Neshaminy Kids Club**

**WHEREAS**, the Neshaminy School District ("School District") has lawful possession either as owner or as a tenant of various Elementary School Buildings located within its geographical limits and those buildings not owned by the School District, School District is permitted under its Lease with the owner of said buildings to sublet portions of those buildings on a per diem basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Neshaminy Elementary School Age Child Care, Pennsylvania Corporation DBA Neshaminy Kids Club ("Neshaminy Kids Club") wishes to continue to conduct after-school private child care programs for elementary school children in regular class rooms and such other areas designated by The School District in one or more elementary school buildings of The School District which programs shall operate during the hours of 3:15 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on all days that School District conducts school sessions; and

**WHEREAS**, The School District and Neshaminy Kids Club desire that Neshaminy Kids Club continue to conduct its after school private child care programs for the term of five (5) years which shall terminate on June 30, 2021 without the necessity of notice from either the School District or Neshaminy Kids Club to the other.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HERE BY RESOLVED** that the Neshaminy Board of School Directors approves the annexed Lease Agreement, authorizes the President and Secretary of the Board to execute said Lease Agreement.

2) **Motion: Mayor's Playground Lease Between NSD and Langhorne Borough**

At the regular meeting of the School Directors of the Neshaminy School District ("School District") for which notice was duly given, held on the 19th day of April, 2016 at the District Office - Board Room of the Maple Point Middle School, 2250 Langhorne-Yardley Road, Langhorne, PA 1904 7.

**WHEREAS**, the Neshaminy School District is amendable to a twenty-five (25) year lease of the Mayor's Playground to the Borough of Langhorne, if within three (3) years, the Borough can qualify for a grant from the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the installation of bathrooms at the Mayor's Playground; and

**WHEREAS**, if the bathroom grant is not secured, the lease shall be for a term of three (3) years beginning on June 1, 2016 and ending on May 31, 2019 and continue from year to year after May 31, 2019 until either party shall give ninety (90) days written notice of its desire to terminate the lease.

**WHEREAS**, if during the said three (3) term, Langhorne Borough secures a grant from the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources then the lease shall convert to a twenty-five (25) year term with an effective date of June 1, 2016 and ending on the 31st day of May 2041, and the term of the lease shall thereafter continue for additional period of five (5) years and so on from term to term until either party shall give the other (180) days written notice of its desire to terminate the lease; and

**WHEREAS**, limit of liability insurance coverage of Langhorne Borough is one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and the School District, as the owner of the property, shall continue to have the property covered under the insurance coverages of the School District. Said insurance limits shall be reviewed by the parties every three (3) years to determine reasonableness or immediately upon termination or modification of the limits of tort immunity in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Neshaminy Board of School Directors approve the said Lease Agreement, which was reviewed by the solicitor, and authorizes the President and Secretary of the Board to sign said Lease Agreement.

**Whereas**, The school district's special education plan is an action plan that describes the local Board of School Director's commitment to ensure that a quality education will be provided to each of its students with a disability eligible for special education, over the upcoming three years...

And, **Whereas** the content of the special education plan describes the special education program and services that are provided within a school district and those special education programs and services which are accessed by the school district from outside the school district's geographical boundaries...

And, **Whereas** each school district shall develop a special education plan aligned with the strategic plan of the school district under PA School Code§ 4.13 (relating to strategic plans).

**Be it resolved** that the Neshaminy Board of School Director's approves the 2016-2019 Neshaminy School District Special Education Plan Report.

John McGinley, VP of Neshaminy Educational Support Professionals Association, resident of Bensalem, asked for clarification about an item on the check register regarding the salary for the STA supervisor, who is no longer employed by the district.

Suzi Drake, teacher, resident of Langhorne, congratulated the Sophomore FPS team (Future Problem Solvers) for placing 2nd in the International Competition.

Board Comment

Mr. Rudy stated that when he mentioned Mr. Rodos's comments of years ago he was actually saying that he agreed with that opinion and he was only sorry now that Mr. Rodos has changed his view on the subject. Mr. Rudy declared that no offense was intended.

Mr. Morris said that the public had an opportunity to vote on the new high school when that issue was going

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on. He said there are differences of opinion on the school Board and everyone has to cooperate and work together, including the public, in order to get things done.

Mr. Congdon clarified that when the public voted on the issue of building a new high school, it was actually a referendum on whether to borrow the money for the project. Despite the fact that they voted not to borrow the money for a new school, the students and teachers were still disrupted due to renovations. He said that keeping disruption to a minimum for the students was something that was considered in the current Road Map plan.
