Dear Parent or Guardian,

Pennsylvania is one of the only states in the nation to offer special health insurance to children with disabilities. The insurance is made possible through Medical Assistance. Participation is voluntary, and there is no cost to the family. If you are insured, Medical Assistance would serve as secondary insurance to the eligible child. It can cover services that your private insurance may not cover, such as special testing or help with paying for glasses, dental or hearing aids. There is no effect on your primary insurance benefits. If your family is uninsured, or loses medical coverage, your eligible child would still be covered under Medical Assistance.
