Maple Point Athletics

The participation in athletics at Maple Point Middle School is a privilege that comes with responsibility. Failure to abide by these guidelines will result in missed playing time and further consequences if needed.

- All student athletes are expected to exhibit MP3 behaviors at all times during the school day and on their athletic playing field.
- Students failing two or more courses will be ineligible to participate for that week until grades are passing, and will attend Homework Club or seek additional help in the classes they are failing until a passing score is maintained.
- No student athlete shall engage in, condone or ignore any form of hazing.
- No student athlete is to engage in conduct constituting sexual harassment or they will be subject to disciplinary action which may include exclusion from athletic activities, detention, suspension, and/or expulsion.
- A student absent from the school day without an excused absence is not allowed to participate in their sport that day (practice or game)
- A student who behaves incorrectly and receives an Office Discipline Referral (ODR) is not permitted to participate in their sport until their punishment is accounted for
- All student athletes must be present at the practice before a game in order to participate.
- It is the responsibility and duty of every student athlete to employ the following principles:
 - 1. We will refrain from heckling officials; we will abide by their decisions.
 - 2. We will give cheers for injured players of BOTH teams.
 - 3. We will refrain from heckling or yelling at players or opponents.
 - 4. We will not applaud any unsportsmanlike conduct on the part of a player.
 - 5. We will refrain from cheering or making noises that are intended to interfere with any type of contest.
 - 6. We will not disturb the rooting section of our opponents; we will respect their opportunity to cheer for their own team.
 - 7. We will observe all regulations of the home school.
 - 8. We will refrain from defacing or disturbing the property or decorations made by the home or visiting school.
 - 9. We will let the contest begin and end with the game.
 - 10. We will endeavor to influence all others and establish ourselves in the way of good school standards and sportsmanship for which Maple Point is well known.
