



# Utilizing Hoonuit (Atomic Learning) to Personalize Professional Learning

## *What is Hoonuit?*

Hoonuit learning is a digital content library that offers over 1,500 hours of online professional development and 60,000 hours of video tutorials and tools on a variety of instructional, technology, and educational topics. Our primary emphasis is on utilizing Atomic Learning for professional development for professional and support staff, but there are also opportunities to utilize this tool with learners, parents, and community members as well.

## *How will Hoonuit enhance the NSD Program?*

- Hoonuit Learning is web-based, educators can access its resources anytime and anywhere.
- Educators can complete an entire training series or access just a section or even a single video on a topic of interest or need.
- Educators can earn Act 48 credit and PD hours by participating in a **qualifying training series**.
- Administrators may recommend specific training series to targeted groups of educators that are relevant to their jobs, and district goals.
- NSD will create and curate our own library of customized-content—learning modules developed in-house to meet our specific needs.

## ***Hoonuit Learning & Act 48***

**Act 48** hours can be granted for completing *Hoonuit Learning* tutorials and learning modules. Hoonuit Learning modules cannot be substituted for contractual obligations such as mandated professional development days. **To receive Act 48 credit for approved learning modules, facilitators must submit a hard copy of the Certificate of Completion that is issued upon completion of a module.**

### ***How To Get Act 48 Credit for Pre-Approved Learning Modules and Tutorials***

In order to receive **Act 48 credit** upon completing a pre-approved learning module:

1. Upload an **artifact** in your *Atomic Learning ePortfolio*.
2. Submit a copy of the *Certificate of Completion* and a *PD Activity Log* together in an email to **Kathy Giambelluca**.

#### NOTES:

- An **artifact** should provide evidence of your understanding and/or application of the training session's content.
- Be sure to record the hours in your **PD Activity Log** as well for PD hours.
- **Tutorials** must be at least one hour in length to be submitted for Act 48 credit.

### ***Completing Additional Learning Modules***

In addition to the 2017-18 pre-approved modules, Facilitators may find additional modules that align to the district vision and have professional growth value. To receive Act 48 credit for additional modules, facilitators should:

- 1) Ensure the learning module outcomes align to our district vision, building and personal professional goals, and will improve instructional practice.
- 2) Receive pre-approval from their building principal.
- 3) Submit the **Certificate of Completion**.
