What does MP3 look like?

- Students are observed doing expected behavior and randomly given an MP3 ticket.
- Students will present their MP3 ticket at lunch (Grades 6, 7, and 8) or during WIN (Grade 5), sign the Celebrity Book, and pick out a number for the Principal's 400 Club.
- Principal's 400 Club: 20x20 rows located on a bulletin board where student tickets will be placed.
- When a winning number is selected, each student in the winning number's row will get a prize.
- The student with the winning number will receive the "Mystery Motivator" prize.
- Each marking period, all MP3
 ticket winners will receive an other ticket to an MP3 As sembly where they will be hon ored and receive more oppor tunities for rewards and priz es.

What are the benefits for Students?

Students will share a common set of expectations throughout their classes and the school. As a result, students will spend more time in a positive learning environment.



How do Students know what is expected?

Behavioral expectations and routines will be taught in classroom and non-classroom settings at the beginning of each year. Students will be taken around the school to stations, where the skills are taught in setting specific locations. Similarly, teachers may choose to teach expectations within each classroom routine as they introduce each routine at the start of the school year. There will be opportunities to review and reteach expected behavior throughout the year.
