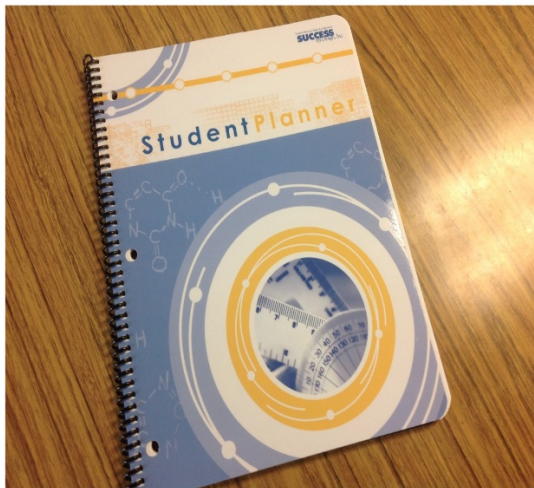
GOOGLE CLASSROOM

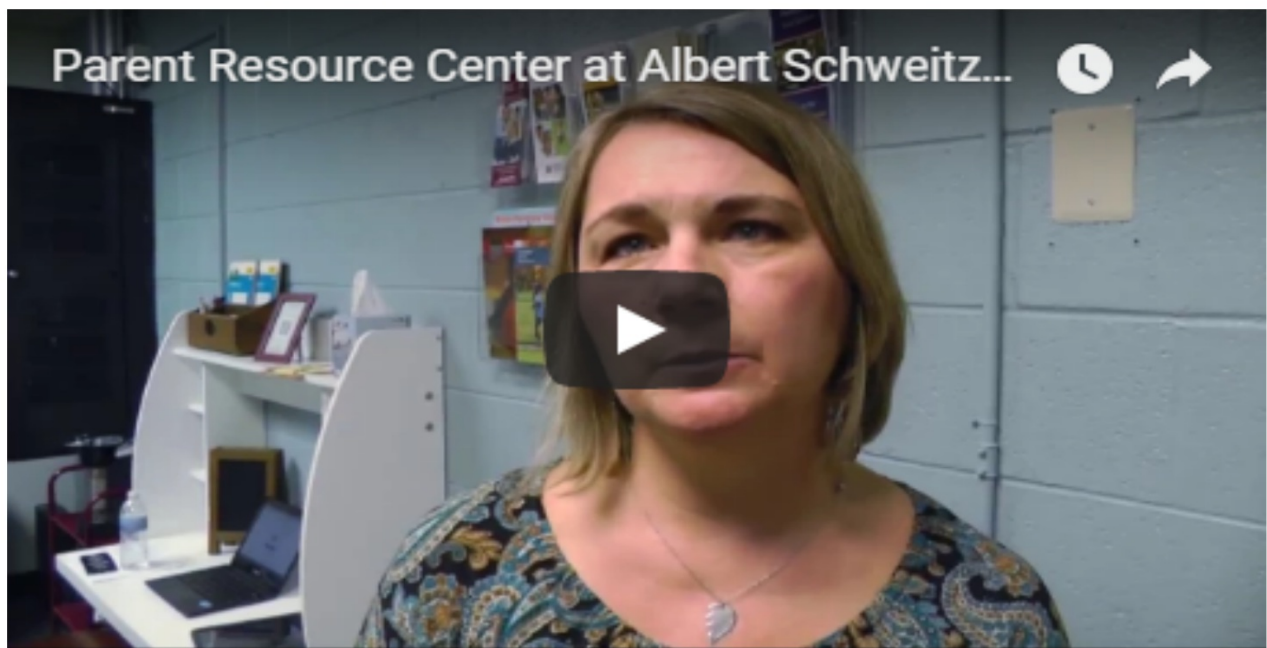
