

## -ug -up -ut -ub -un

Four  $\frac{1}{2}$  page worksheets for each group of words (usually a group is one word family, but a couple of groups are combined, such as -ub and -un)

For each group of words, students will

- 1. read words and cut/glue pictures to match
- 2. Cut/glue letters to make words from the word family3. Write words from the word family
  - 4. Write words from previously taught word families
- 5. Write a sentence using a word from the word family.




