Language Arts

In reading, we are focusing on non-fiction and non-fiction text features. We are practicing summarizing and retelling important information in the text. We will continue to work on these skills throughout the school year. We also read several articles about Veterans Day. We are reviewing parts of speech (nouns, verbs, and adjectives). We are reading stories and paying close attention to descriptive language.

SCIENCE

This week we completed our work with plants and seeds. We played fun review games and practiced making our own questions! We will begin learning about crayfish and beetles!

Math

This week we began learning about graphing. The children are learning that there are different kinds of graphs and how to interpret data. We are learning that there is a title, an x-axis, and a y-axis. To help remember this we say “x to the left, y to the sky”. We are working on highlighting or “tornado” important information within a question to ensure that we understand what we are reading and performing the correct operation.
