Language Arts

In reading, we continue to work on making predictions, making connections, and finding the author's purpose. As we read different stories the children are encourage to ask themselves important questions. For example, your child might stop and make a prediction about what they think will happen next. In writing, we continue to enjoy different mentor texts. This week we focused on different memories. feelings, and using vivid details in our writing. The children are working hard on different personal narratives.

Social Studies

This week we continued to strengthen our map skills. We are researching famous landmarks in the United States and making a diorama!

Math

This week we wrapped up our first two units. These units focused on review from last year and helped us strengthen our number sense by looking at place value and rounding. It also warmed us up for addition and subtraction. Over the next two weeks we will be moving through working on addition and subtraction to 1,000. I encourage you to work on these skills at home with your child with the use of online math tools and review. You have access to IXL and think central through Clever. Some math vocabulary to use at home are words like sum, regroup, and difference. A math packet will be coming home Monday.
