Good Evening Neshaminy,

This evening, the Neshaminy Board of School Directors voted, 8-0, to continue as planned with moving the Elementary Schools to an “in school 4-day a week” model beginning on Monday, November 30.

- If you are presently in Blue/Red Hybrid and wish to move to Plan A, In-School 4 days, do nothing as this option is the default.
- If you are presently in either Plan D option and wish to remain in that option, do nothing as this is also the default.
- If you are presently in Blue/Red Hybrid but do not wish to move to Plan A, call/email Trish to move to either Plan D Option (215-809-7777 or questions@neshaminy.org).

Along with this move, the following modifications to the Neshaminy K12 Health & Safety Plan were approved:

1. The face covering requirement will no longer permit Face Shields as a voluntary option. Face Shields are permissible only if other options are not feasible for the individual.
2. Student Mask Breaks will continue to occur only when students are at least 6-feet apart.
3. Reduce unnecessary mixing of student groups at all levels.
4. In-door air quality improvements begin November 30 using bi-polar ionization (BPI) and ultra-violet germicidal irradiation (UVGI) prioritizing Elementary Schools installation.
5. Partner with CHOP to provide Rapid COVID Testing to students and staff (with permission, of course).
6. Add Contact Tracing Personnel as needed.

At all levels, keeping our schools open is a function of:

1. Expedited Contact Tracing and Exclusions/Quarantines
2. The virus not spreading in the school environment
3. Daily Staffing Levels

I, and the entire Neshaminy Cabinet, monitor each of the above daily. If our success in these areas change, so will the instructional model on a level-by-level, school-by-school, program-by-program and day-by-day basis. Problems will be addressed swiftly but “with a scalpel instead of a mallet.”

Please continue to follow your Family’s Health & Safety Plan so we can continue to provide in-school instruction for Neshaminy families.
