

Tips for Cleaning Your Chromebook

Always make sure your device is powered off and disconnect any peripheral cables or USB devices (such as a wireless mouse) before you begin any cleaning.

Use bleach-free disinfectant wipes or a solution of 40 percent of rubbing alcohol and 60 percent distilled water. *Note: Using full-strength rubbing alcohol can damage the oil-repellent (oleophobic) coating that helps to keep smudges off of the touch screen.*

If using a cloth, it is best to use microfiber cloths that are lint free.

Never spray anything directly onto your Chromebook. Spray cleaner onto your cloth and then wipe the device. Allow the device to dry before using.

If you are using a pre-moistened wipe, you may wish to use a dry microfiber cloth after wiping the device and the device dries to remove any haze that could be left from the cleaner.
