Choose a book with a cover in your favorite color

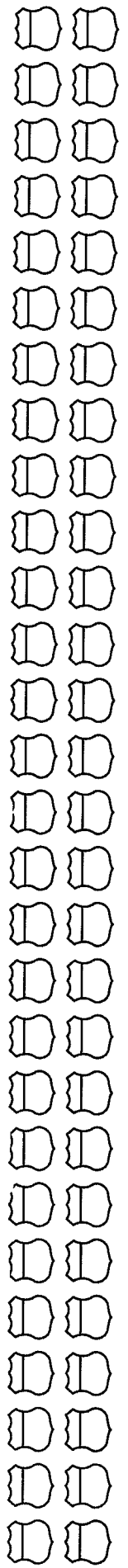
Find an author from your state and read one of their books
