Angels in Motion is an organization of volunteers that are trying to change the way those suffering with the disease of addiction are treated. Volunteers go to the streets of Philadelphia and hand out "Blessing Bags", clothing and toiletries. Each blessing bag contains snacks, an encouragement note and a resource packet with information and phone numbers to call when seeking medical help, shelter or a path to recovery.

Student volunteers at the event will participate in the following four stations:

- 2) Assembling "Blessing Bags"
- 3) Making Plarn (plastic yarn) for sleeping mats
