CHROMEBOOK DISTRIBUTION

Distribution (August 24-September 4, 2020)

Beginning, Monday August 24[,] 2020, parents/guardians can pick up devices for Neshaminy students. Devices can be picked up anytime Monday, Wednesday, Friday between 8:00 AM-4:00 PM or Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 4:00-8:00 PM at Neshaminy High School. <u>Appointments are not necessary</u>. Staff will be available during the times outlined for parents to drive up to the distribution site at the High School and request a device.

All 5th grade parents **MUST complete the Parental Form prior to picking up a new device. Please use the link below to access this form.** In addition, each year all 5th grade students will receive a new Chromebook that remains with them until they graduate from Neshaminy. We plan to continue providing all incoming 5th grade students with a new Chromebook. If your child is entering 5th grade, they can pick up their new device during the same distribution window outlined. If your child received a Chromebook last year in 4th grade, you can return the previously borrowed Chromebook when your child picks up the new 5th grade Chromebook, or your child can swap it out when they attend the 5th grade Orientation Day at their school in September.

Parents will not need to leave their car for pick-up. A representative from the Technology Department will meet each family at their car. Parents/guardians will be asked to provide the following information for their child/children:

- 1. First and Last Name
- 2. Name of School
- 3. Grade

Once the information above is provided, a device (with power cord and bag) will be scanned and provided for each child. Parents will receive a notification receipt of the specific device received via email. Currently, once you log in to your chrome book, the educational package is not available to students yet. This will be updated shortly.

CANVAS – Maple Point's Learning Management System

For the 2020-21 school year, all teachers are using Canvas. Canvas is the learning management system used by the Neshaminy School District. This is a one-stop shop for information. You can view assignments, and student work. The only information you will not be able to access is student grades. Parents will still use Home Access to view grades.

All students will have a Canvas account. Parents will be directed to a teacher's Canvas site should they go to a teachers website.

STUDENT ARRIVAL and DISMISSAL

STUDENT DROP OFF TIMES – NEW THIS YEAR. This year, students will report to their ^{1st} period core class for the day as they enter the building. For 7th grade, this means they report to their 2nd period for attendance purposes. Students may enter starting at <u>7:25</u>

Students riding the bus, per the Commonwealth's order, must wear a mask.

<u>Students are not permitted to enter the building before 7:25 a.m</u>, unless they are involved in a scheduled co-curricular program. For the safety and well-being of all our students as they arrive each day we want to ensure sufficient staff supervision in the building.

- <u>There are two drop off and pick up points for walkers and car riders. EACH IS</u> <u>A ONE WAY TRAFFIC PATTERN. Please see the pictures following this</u> <u>information.</u>
- Parents dropping or picking up students off are asked to use either entrance: Langhorne Yardley Road or Woodbourne Road. Whichever you choose, please leave using the same way. We expect more traffic in our parking lots and student safety is PARAMOUNT. Parents are not permitted to park in parking spots to drop or pick up students. Please stay in line and pull up to the gym or auditorium in the car line to have your students enter or exit your car. To help insure the safety of students and drivers, one-way patterns are in effect at all times during drop off and pickups. Parents dropping off and picking up students during bus transport times <u>cannot</u> use the rear parking area. The back of the building is off limits. Doors will open at 7:25 a.m. and pickup will occur at 2:55 p.m. We ask that you pull close to the curb to avoid blocking the drive.
- We will have adults and signage out to direct traffic as we become familiar with the new traffic patterns. We appreciate your patience as we institute this change in order to make sure students are safe and traffic flows the best that it can.
- Early dismissals and late drop off may still use the front entrance during non-busing times (7:55 2:55).

Please review the pictures for drop off and arrival procedures. All buses will enter from Woodbourne Road and travel the yellow route to the back of the building to drop off and pick up students.

An FYI...from the District.

"Neshaminy School District has engaged Eagle Industrial Hygiene Assoc., Inc., to fulfill the requirements of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), 40 CFR Part 763, Subpart E. This law requires that each Local Education Authority (LEA) engage EPA accredited individuals to initially inspect and subsequently re-inspect every three years all student and staff accessed areas for the presence of both friable and non-friable asbestos containing materials (ACM) and to develop an Asbestos Management Plan from the information developed from the building inspections. All areas of our facilities were inspected for asbestos-containing materials. The Management Plan provides a description of the amount, type, location and condition of all ACM found in these areas. The Plan also contains a detailed schedule of responses and activities for handling the ACM. The Management Plan is available for review by interested parents, faculty and staff in all school offices during business hours.
