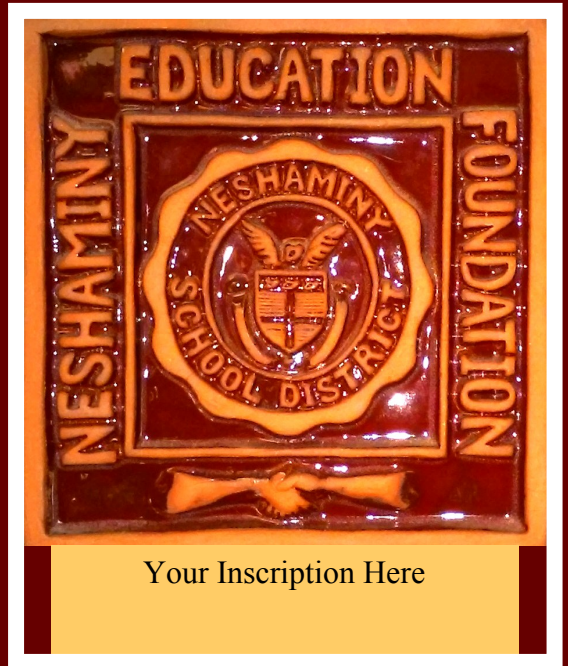

Financial support for the Foundation is provided through Neshaminy employee payroll deduction and through generous gifts and donations from individuals and groups as well as through fund-raising activities.

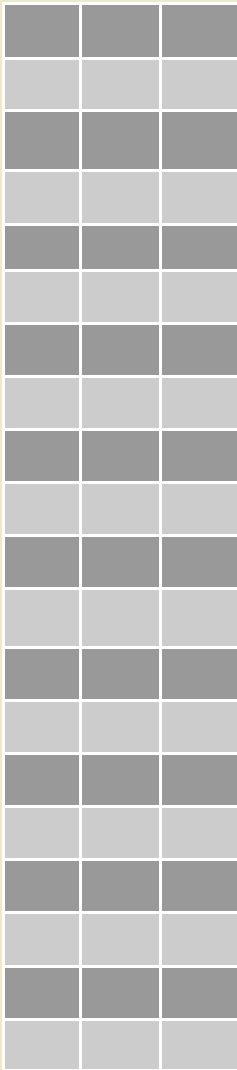
What We Do

The Endowment Wall and Its Purpose

In order to establish a long range and permanent source of funding for its projects, the Neshaminy Education Foundation, through its Board of Directors, developed the idea of an Endowment fund financed by a tiled wall with brass engraved plates recognizing contributors. The tiles are designed by Stephen Cohen and hand-made by Mandy Baker in the tradition of Henry Mercer's Moravian Pottery and Tile Works in Doylestown, PA. Actual size of the tile is 4.5 inches square.

Now retired from teaching, he still creates art work for clients in a variety of media and serves on the Neshaminy Education Foundation Board of Directors.

Mandy Baker is a Bucks County, Pennsylvania native and accomplished ceramic artist whose work has appeared in such prestigious magazines as Studio Potter and Architectural Digest. A graduate of Thiel College with a degree in Fine Arts, Ms. Baker began her concentration tile making working for the Moravian Pottery and Tile Works in Doylestown, PA. She held the position of Head Ceramist for eight years at which time she mastered traditional tile making techniques and production responsibilities. To pursue her own tile designs, she became a partner in a local tile studio for ten years before establishing Whispering Hill Studio in 1998.

Inspired by nature and Arts and Craft style, you can witness some of her twenty five years of designs installed in the Mercer Museum, Doylestown Firehouse, Central Bucks East High School as well as many private homes and businesses throughout the East Coast.
