The non-profit 501(c)(3) Neshaminy Education Foundation (NEF) is proud to serve the Neshaminy School District by providing instructional grants and student scholarships. Established in 1993, the NEF has awarded hundreds of thousands of dollars for innovative projects through an annual teacher grant program (see the reverse side of this letter for more information). The Foundation also awards college scholarships to graduating seniors at Neshaminy High School each year.

This year we altered our grant program due to the pandemic. Covid-19 has been a major logistical and financial challenge for our schools. Instead of awarding individual grants, the NEF responded with an \$18,000 check to provide 435 headset microphones for instructional use. These microphones greatly improved the audio quality between teachers and students joining classes online remotely. As the pandemic progresses, more instructional and safety needs will be recognized. Several projects that need funding have already been identified.

As the calendar year draws to a close, we would like to invite you and your business to join us in a partnership to keep our schools safe and our children learning. 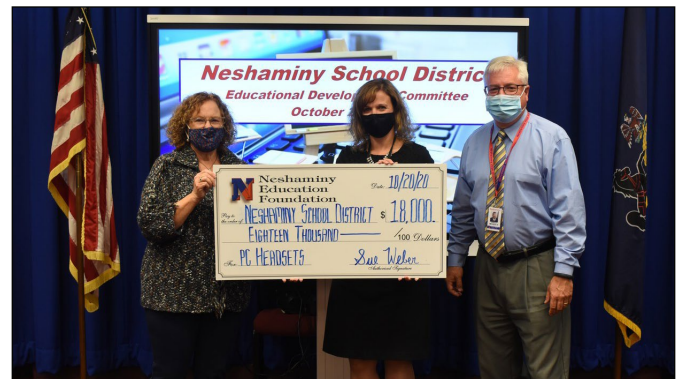
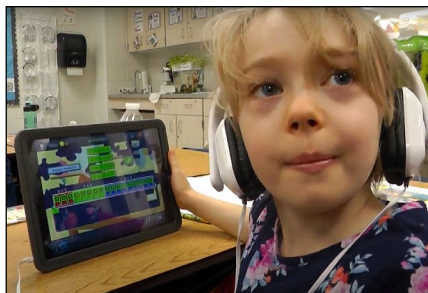


WE HELP BUILD FUTURES!
