

## 7th Grade Supply List



Label all supplies with your first and last name.

We will organize and label our items together!

It would be best if all students have these supplies on the first day of school.

However, students are expected to have all supplies as soon as possible.

- Two three ring binders –2 inch
- Four plastic cover spirals: One subject, college ruled, size: 9 X 11, 100 pages each  
(Example: Five Star one subject spiral)
- Eleven tab dividers
- 10-25 Sheet Protectors – Heavy Duty
- Loose leaf paper—a generous supply
- A dry erase marker
- A ruler (to be kept at home) one side should be metric and one side should measure inches.
- Calculator—Texas Instruments model TI30XIIS is preferred by Poquessing Math teachers. Watch for sales. It can be found for less than \$15. If you decide to get a different calculator, be sure that it adds, subtracts, multiplies, divides, is able to handle signed numbers, and has a square root key.
- Pencil case
- Glue—8 oz. Elmer’s or 10 glue sticks
- Earbuds (Note - If in Read 180, earbuds with a microphone will be required.)
- Many pencils
- Erasers
- Highlighters (Yellow & maybe a variety of colors)
- Blue or black pens
- Colored pencils
- Sticky notes (many & the cheaper the better)
- Tissues for your homeroom classroom
- Small pencil sharpener
- Reinforcements
- Small pair of scissors
- One medium binder clip
- Hand sanitizer (optional)
- Drawstring Gym Bag
- “Masterlock” or equivalent combination lock
