1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15		<ul> <li>Policy #532 (con't)</li> <li>Smoking and tobacco use by all members of the general public are prohibited 24 hours a day, 365 days per year in all District facilities and buildings and on buses, vans or other vehicles owned by, leased by, or under the control of the Neshaminy School District; on property owned by, leased by, or under the control of the Neshaminy School District; at school-sponsored events on and off campus; and those functions not associated with or sponsored by the school.</li> <li>To implement and define the prohibitions established by this policy, the Neshaminy School District shall post No Tobacco Use signs at entrances to all District facilities and buildings and in such other areas as necessary.
