TITLE: CONTROL OF SCABIES INFECTION

1	PURPOSE	The purpose of this policy is to prevent the spread of scabies from an infected	1	
2		student to other children in the Neshaminy school age population.	2	
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4	DEFINITIONS	For the purpose of this policy, Scabies Infection shall refer to the identification	4	
5		of objective symptoms resulting from exposure to the scabies mite:	5	
6		a discolored zigzag track or furrow near the skin surface.	6	
7		intense itching in the area of the skin eruption.	7	
8		disclosure of other family members with a diagnosis of scabies.	8

10	POLICY	No student may attend any Neshaminy School nor any of its programs while	10	
11		suffering from scabies infection. Neshaminy School District supports the	11	
12		recommendation of the Pennsylvania Department of Health regarding the	12	
13		exclusion of students identified with scabies infection.	13

15		Exclusion Procedures to Control Scabies Infection - Any student referred to	15	
16		the school health suite for suspicion of scabies infection shall be examined by	16	
17		the certified school nurse. If the student is found to have symptoms consistent	17	
18		with scabies infection, the following steps are taken:	18	
19		The parent or guardian is notified that the student has been excluded from	19	
20		the school environment and must be taken for medical evaluation and	20	
21		treatment.	21	
22		Upon arrival at the school to retrieve the student, the parent or guardian	22	
23		shall receive the district letter describing the policy for scabies infection as	23	
24		well as the recommendations for care of the student with a scabies	24	
25		infection.	25	
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27		Readmission of Students Excluded for Scabies Infection - Students excluded	27	
2 8		for scabies infection may return to the school environment as soon as they	28	
29		have been examined and treated by a physician. A note from the physician	29	
30		may be required to verify treatment. Students may still have skin irritation on	30	
31		their return to school but are deemed non-contagious following the	31	
32		pharmacological treatment for scabies.	32
