You are invited to attend NHS's FAFSA Completion Night on **Wednesday, February 5, from 6pm – 8pm**, **in the Neshaminy High School Library**. This is the perfect time to get help with the financial aid process if you have a 12<sup>th</sup> grade student attending college next year. Once you have completed the registration you will need to get a Federal Student AID (FSA) ID. The FSA ID is a username and password that you will use to log in to certain US Dept of Education websites and will also be used to electronically sign the FAFSA once you have it completed. You will need to have this ID number before you attend the FAFSA Night on February 5.

- To create at FSA ID go to <a href="https://fsaid.ed.gov/">https://fsaid.ed.gov/</a>
- Both the student and any parent who will be electronically signing the FAFSA will need their own separate FSA ID.
- Please note it takes 3-5 days to receive your FSA ID once you sign up for one.
- If you encounter difficulty obtaining your FSA ID please call 1-800-4 FED-AID for assistance.

On February 5, you will need to bring with you the following items:

- Social Security Number
- Driver's License Number/State ID Card
- Alien Registration Number, if you are not a US Citizen
- Your tax forms, and your W-2 for the 2017 and 2018 calendar year
- Records of any other untaxed income, including worker's compensation, child supportreceived and paid, payments to tax deferred pension and savings plan, etc.
- Your current bank statements and records of stocks, bonds and other investments

If you are a Dependent Student, you will also need:

- Your parent's Parents Social Security number
- Your parent's income and financial records (as listed above)

Please remember to register for the event and create a FSA pin beforehand. Also, please note this event is <u>only</u> for families of 12 grade students who are attending college next year and have not yet completed the FAFSA.
