

NHS SENIOR PARKING CONTRACT 2019-20

Please read below and apply ONLY if you meet the requirements.

Do I qualify for the Senior Parking Privilege?

You do if you had:

- 16 or fewer lates to school in the 2018-19 school year (average 4/mp).
- 12 or fewer absences in the 2018-19 school year (average 3/mp).
- No more than two F's in the 2018-19 school year.
- No more than 2 suspensions in the 2018-19 school year.
- No obligations to the School District in the form of property, money or time (i.e. After School Detentions, etc.)

If you didn't meet the criteria for the August lottery, you may ask to be reconsidered at the beginning of the 2nd marking period based on your performance on the above qualifiers in the 1st marking period.

*****Having an after-school job does not impact your getting a parking permit*****

OK! I meet all the above criteria, now what?

Complete the application and MAIL it to: NHS Grade 12 – PARKING – 2001 Old Lincoln Hwy., Langhorne, PA 19047, Attn: Mr. Mueller, with a postmark of no later than Wednesday, July 31, 2019.

A lottery drawing will be held on August 20, and results will be posted on the Neshaminy website by 3 p.m. that day.

YAY! 😊 I was chosen in the lottery! How do I get my parking decal?

Come to the Grade 12 Office on Thursday, August 22, or Friday, August 23, between the hours of 8:00 to 11:00 a.m. or 12:30 – 2:00 p.m.

Bring:

- Valid registration card for the car you are registering
- Valid insurance card
- Valid driver's license
- A check for \$45 made out to Neshaminy High School

Where and by When do I park on campus?

In the Specific Lot to which you are assigned ONLY and **You Must be in that Lot by 7:00 A.M.**

Where do I park when I come in late?

In your Assigned Lot ONLY. You must then walk to the front entrance and sign in at the Security Desk.

Where, on my car, does the parking decal go?

On the bottom right side of the windshield using the adhesive provided on the decal (no taping). Your decal is not transferable to any other car or person. Decal must match the registered car.

What are the traffic laws on campus?

Speed limit 15 mph.

Yield the right-of-way to school buses

If an accident or incident of theft or vandalism should happen, do not move your car until told to do so by the Grade 12 Office. Middletown Police will be notified if necessary.

What could cause me to lose my parking privilege?

Attendance:

12 absences

4 lates to school in a marking period. ***(Student drivers must be parked by 7 a.m. and ON TIME FOR HOMEROOM).***

6 lates to class

Cutting class

Leaving campus before your dismissal time without permission from the Attendance Office

Taking another student off campus before 2:15 p.m.

Academics:

More than one F in any marking period

Behavior:

2 suspensions

1 School Board Policy Violation

Entering the parking lot once the school day begins without a pass from the Grade 12 Office

Reckless driving on campus

Allowing another student to drive your car on campus

Driver or passengers acting inappropriately. "Horseplay" or reckless or dangerous act on campus (i.e. driving on surfaces other than the driveway, speeding, yelling, horn blowing, riding on outside of car, hanging out of car, throwing balls or other objects)

Moving your car out of turn or cutting into the exit line at dismissal time

General:

- **Car trouble and traffic are not excuses for lateness to school.**
- Accept full responsibility for losses due to accident, theft or vandalism occurring on campus.
- Notify your Lot Attendant of a short-term change of car **before entering the building.**
- Make a permanent car change in the Grade 12 Office **before you drive the new car.**
- Revoked permits must be removed from the car and turned in at the Grade 12 office immediately.
- Student drivers will not be released earlier than the general student body on Snow Days.
- The parking fee is non-refundable.

By parking a car on NSD property, you are consenting to a search of the car upon the request of NHS administration in the interest of preventing its use for illegal purposes and to protect the welfare of the student body.

NESHAMINY HIGH SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE YOUR PERMIT TO PARK FOR ISSUES OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFICALLY STATED ABOVE.

- Check here if you are enrolled with full schedule of classes at NHS for your senior year.
- Check here if you are enrolled in the BCCC Dual-Enrollment Program for your senior year.
- Check here if you are enrolled in the Seniors Privilege Program for your senior year.
