NHS SENIOR PARKING 2025-26

APPLICATION & CONTRACT

Senior Privilege and BCCC Student Drivers must apply

Do I qualify for a Student Parking? If you can say YES to all of the following, you do:

- You are a SENIOR.
- You have no financial obligation to NHS.
- You are a student in good standing in academics and discipline.
- Your attendance in your junior year was not in violation of Board Policy 212.

How do I apply for a student parking permit?

- Complete the application below.
- Sign the contract (along with your guardian) agreeing to the terms of parking on campus.
- Print out a copy of these four (4) documents: (1) Registration Card for your ONE (1) car
 (2) Proof of Insurance (3) Driver's License and (4) Bus Waiver.
- Place the 4 documents and a check for \$45 in a <u>sealed</u> envelope, marked SENIOR PARKING, NESHAMINY HIGH SCHOOL.
- Drop the envelope off at the high school Main Lobby (window next to security) no later than **Thursday**, **JULY 10**, **2025**, **AT 2:00 P.M.**

When do I pick up the decal for my car?

Permit decals may be picked up starting on Thursday, August 21, 2025, and any weekday thereafter in the Grade 12 Office between the hours of 7:30 and 11:30 a.m. and 1:15 and 2:15 in the afternoon.

Where on my car must the decal be?

Bottom passenger side of the front windshield by using the adhesive that comes on the decal. Taping or leaning is not permitted (<u>because decal may never be transferred to</u> a different car).

Where and when will I park?

In the lot that is assigned to you when you pick up your decal, **never anywhere else for any reason**. Arrive at your lot by 7 a.m. so you're sure to be seated in Period 1 by 7:21 a.m.

What if I come in late?

Never deviate from your assigned lot for any reason whatsoever. After 7:21 a.m., you must use the front entrance **ONLY**. Ring the buzzer and sign in at the Main Lobby.

What are the campus traffic laws?

- All PA driving laws are in force.
- The campus speed limit is 15 mph.
- Yielding right-of-way to school buses and pedestrians is mandatory.

What are the behaviors that will put my parking privilege at risk for suspension or loss?

- Not coming to school on time.
- Discipline issues
- Failing grades
- Poor attendance
- Transferring the permit issued for your car to a different car.
- Lending your car or permit to another student.
- Returning to your car without a pass from your grade-level office.
- Parking outside your assigned lot.
- Breaking campus traffic laws.
- Leaving campus without permission from your grade-level and attendance office.
- Taking another student off campus before their dismissal time.
- Inappropriate behavior in a parking/driving situation by you <u>or a passenger in your car</u>. For example (but not limited to) recklessness, horseplay, driving on surfaces not meant for driving, doing donuts, speeding, yelling, horn-blowing, throwing objects, people hanging out of the car or riding on the outside of the car.
- Moving your car out of turn or cutting the exit line at dismissal.
- Insubordination to parking attendants.

Things to Know and Remember

- Car trouble and traffic are not excuses for lateness to school. You are to be here at 7 am
- You are responsible for losses due to accidents, theft or vandalism involving your car.
- Your after-school job has no bearing on your parking on campus. No leaving early or parking in a preferred lot to accommodate an after-school job.
- To park a different car short-term, tell the Gr.12 office before you do it.
- For a permanent change of car, present registration and insurance proof to your gradelevel office. Turn in your original decal for a different number.
- You will not be released earlier than other students in bad weather conditions.
- Do not move your car until allowed by administration in the case of an accident or vandalism.
- If you have an occasion to need school bus transportation after signing the waiver, contact the Grade 12 office.
- The parking fee is non-refundable.

By parking a vehicle on NSD property, you consent and are subject to a search of the vehicle at the request of NHS administration in the interest of school safety and/or preventing the use of the student's assigned vehicle for illegal substances and/or safety-related items.

Neshaminy School District reserves the right to revoke any Student Parking privilege as a result of issues other than those specifically outlined. This may include, but is not limited to, excessive student absences, student lateness or any violations of the NHS Discipline Code. When a student's parking privilege has been revoked, the district will seek alternative methods of transportation.

SENIOR PARKING PERMIT HOLDERS AND THEIR ADULT CO-SIGNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE INFORMATION IN THIS CONTRACT.

Student Driver Bus Waiver

By signing this waiver and requesting student-driver status for your child, you as the parent/guardian agree to relinquish your child's seat on Neshaminy School District buses for the 2025-2026 school year. By signing this waiver your child is responsible for their own transportation even if the student is having mechanical or other issues with their registered vehicle on a particular school day or in case the student violates campus parking rules and experiences a suspension of parking privileges, described in part below:

- Parking is a privilege and is available to seniors in good academic and disciplinary standing with good records of attendance. Students who exceed 10 unexcused tardy arrivals to school will have their parking privileges suspended for one month. At the end of that month, they may submit a written request to their grade level principal to regain the privilege to park. Students who exceed 15 unexcused tardy arrivals will lose parking privileges for the remainder of the school year.
- For a temporary suspension of parking privileges, the parent/guardian will be responsible for their students' transportation to and from school during the month of suspension.
- If a student loses their parking privileges for the year, they will be re-assigned a seat on a bus.

By proceeding with the application process for a Neshaminy High School parking permit, your child's seat will be reassigned to another student.
