## The Five Finger Rule

The five finger rule may be used to help your child choose a book at the correct level.

- 1. Choose a book you would like to read.
- 2. Open the book to any page in the book and begin to read.
- 3. Every time you do not know a word, hold up a finger.
- 4. If you know every word on the page, the book is too easy and you may want to choose a more difficult book.
- 5. If you do not know more than five words on the page, the book is a little too hard for you, so you should choose an easier book.
- 6. If you miss one to five words on the page, the book should be just right for you.
