

SPRING BREAK RENOVATIONS

During spring break, Reynolds Energy Services will be removing the drop ceiling tiles and some grid in all Schweitzer and Hoover Elementary School classrooms. Four feet of ceiling tile and grid along the exterior wall will be removed after the children are out for break to allow for work during the spring break and during nights/weekends after spring break. During the break, the ceilings will be removed, general cleaning above the ceilings will occur, and work will begin in the ceiling space.
