
Dear Parent/Guardians:



#### What did we learn this year?

Every year we build upon and study the elements of art and principles of design, but here are few major areas covered in each grade level this year....

#### **Kindergarten Highlights:**

Texture, self portraits, color mixing, line, shape and clay owls.

#### **1st Grade Highlights:**

Vincent Van Gogh, texture, symmetry, shape, pattern, form, color, weaving, clay flowers, self-portraiture, clay pinch pot animals, line, landscape, and visual perspective.

#### **2nd Grade Highlights:**

M.C. Escher, tessellations, gesture drawing, working with wire, clay castles, clay coil pots, radial symmetry, landscape, visual perspective, "stained glass" Georgia O'Keefe flowers and Kandinsky abstract painting.

<u>3rd Grade Highlights:</u> Positive/negative space, color, balance, weaving, clay bowls with a pond theme, Latin American folk art/symbols, Molas, clay plates, line, pattern, radial symmetry, land-scape, visual perspective and Vincent Van Gogh.

#### 4th Grade Highlights:

Clay Gargoyles, radial symmetry designs, line, shape, color, pattern, cup drawings from observation, focal point, pattern, symmetry, masterpieces/aster artists, mosaics and linear perspective.

#### **5th Grade Highlights:**

Self portraits, facial proportion, Chuck Close portraits, texture, color, Zentangle designs, line, pattern, composition, artist statements, clay tiles, clay boxes, animal illusions, color schemes, drawing from life (still life), abstract, gradation, value and linear perspective.









Many of you have been given **C.A.R.E.S.** stickers by teachers, aides, bus drivers and our custodians throughout the school year.


