Dear Schweitzer Families:

Now that October is here and the beginning of the year procedures are set in place, all students are in full learning mode!

Our guiding reading groups have begun, and this year, we will be teaching our students the four strategies of reciprocal teaching. Those "Fab Four" are: questioning, predicting, clarifying, and summarizing. When using the strategies, each student takes a turn at being the "teacher", and often the teacher and students take turns leading a discussion about sections of the text that they are reading. The aim is to help students actively bring meaning to the text, and help them to learn to monitor their own learning and thinking. This strategy was studied and was found to have a significant effect on student learning. If you would like to learn more about reciprocal teaching, please talk to your child's teacher, or ask to speak to our reading specialist, Mrs. Nicole Mascione.
