14	III. SECRETARY	During the month of May (starting with 1953), the Board shall elect a	14
15	24 PS 4 431-433	Secretary to serve for a period of four years, beginning the first Monday of	15
16		July following the election. In school districts of the second class, this	16
17		person shall not be a member of the Board, except as noted in The School	17
18		Laws of Pennsylvania. Compensation shall be determined by the Board.	18

20		Note: The next election of Secretary in the Neshaminy District shall be in	20
21		May 1985 and every four years thereafter. This conforms to The School	21
22		Laws of Pennsylvania.	22
