1	I. PURPOSE	The Neshaminy School District has determined that smoking and tobacco use	1	
2		create a health hazard for both the smoker and nonsmoker. Therefore, the	2	
3		Neshaminy School District wishes to establish a policy restricting smoking and	3	
4		tobacco use in the Neshaminy School District for the express purpose of	4	
5		protecting the health, safety, and welfare of its students, its employees, and the	5

8 9	II. DEFINITIONS	• Smoking shall mean possession of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or similar object formed of or containing tobacco or other vegetable substance.	8	
10		Tobacco Use shall mean smoking and the use of smokeless tobacco in any	10	
11		form.	11	
12		Public Meetings shall mean all meetings open to the public pursuant to	12	
13		Act of July 3, 1989 (P.L> 388, No. 85) known as the <i>Sunshine Act</i> .	13	
14		District Facilities and Buildings shall mean lobbies, hallways,	14	
15		instructional areas, school buses, and other school vehicles utilized	15	
16		for the conveyance of students and District employees.	16	
17		No Tobacco Use Sign shall mean a sign or placard, the contents of which	17	
18		shall notify the viewer that smoking and tobacco use, as defined herein,	18	
19 20		is prohibited and that violation of that prohibition shall result in sanctions set forth in this Policy.	19 20	
21		"Pupil" means a person who is at least six (6) years of age but not more	21	
22		than twenty-one (21) years of age and who is enrolled in a school. For	22	
23		purposes of this sections, this definition shall not include an individual	23	
24		eighteen (18) years of age or older who is enrolled in an adult education	24

27	III.	Smoking and tobacco use by employees of Neshaminy School District is	27	
28	PROHIBITION	prohibited, 24 hours a day, 365 days per year, in all District facilities and	28

Policy #332 (con't) Smoking and tobacco use by all members of the general public is prohibited, 24 hours a day, 365 days per year, in all District facilities and buildings and on buses, vans or other vehicles owned by, leased by or under the control of the Neshaminy School District; on property owned by, leased by or under the control of the Neshaminy School District; and at school-sponsored functions on as well as off-property, as well as those not associated with or sponsored by the school. To implement and define the prohibitions established by this policy, the Neshaminy School District shall post No Tobacco Use signs at entrances to all District facilities and buildings and in such other areas as necessary. Said No Tobacco Use signs shall refer to this policy and its prohibitions and shall state that violation of this policy shall result in the sanctions set forth herein. IV. Advertising of tobacco products is prohibited in school buildings, on school **ADVERTISEMENT** property, at school functions and in all school publications. This includes clothing worn by students, staff, and visitors, that advertises tobacco PA Department of products. Sponsorship from any tobacco industry affiliate will not be Health (2011) accepted. V. SUPPORTS The Neshaminy School District will offer smoking cessation classes to any employee who requests support in his/her effort to stop smoking. The first **OFFERED** time the District will pay the complete fee for each employee. If an employee PA Department of Health (2011) requests an additional set of smoking cessation classes, only 50 percent of the fee will be paid by the District. Any employee who violates this Policy shall be subject to the disciplinary actions set forth in School Board Polices 227,327, or 427 with the exception that termination of employment will not be imposed. Under appropriate circumstances, violators may be prosecuted for the fines authorized by the Approved: 3/27/90 Clean Indoor Air Act. Revised: 2/23/93 Any member of the general public found smoking or using tobacco Revised: 8/23/94 products will be asked by the appropriate school official to refrain from Revised: 3/10/97 smoking or tobacco use while on District property.
