1	I. PURPOSE	The Board of Education encourages the admission of all eligible students in	1	
2		our schools. Verifications of eligibility shall be the duty of the administrators	2	
3		in order to avoid student overcrowding and to protect our taxpayers from	3	
4		unwanted financial burden.	4

6	II. DEFINITION	"Residence" shall mean the domicile or place where a student lives or his/her	6	
7		home with the intention that it is her/her home permanently or indefinitely.	7	
8		It is the place to which, whenever she/he is absent, she/he has the intention	8	
9		of returning. Ownership of a property in and of itself does not constitute	9	
10		residency.	10

12	III. PROOF OF	Parents or guardians of students registering in the Neshaminy School District	12	
13	RESIDENCE	must present acceptable documents to prove their residency in the Neshaminy	13	
14		School District.	14	
15		Parents or guardians who are unable to produce acceptable documents of	15	
16		residency will not be permitted to register their student in the Neshaminy	16	
17		School District.	17	
18		In order to establish school district residency, the following documents shall	18	
19		be considered:	19	
20		• The lease or purchase of a dwelling; (dated and signed rental contract,	20	
21		deeds, dated and signed settlement papers).	21	
22		• Payment of appropriate state and local taxes (present tax statement or bill	22	
23		bearing the dwelling address).	23	
24		Current address on driver's license.	24	
25		• The provision of a notarized statement to reside indefinitely in the school	25	
26		district.	26	
27		• Current utility bills and statements bearing the dwelling address.	27	
28		Affidavits of Support (to be reviewed annually by Pupil Services	28	
29		Department).	29

31	IV. REMOVAL	Students who have been admitted to school and who subsequently are found	31	
32	OF STUDENTS	not to meet residency criteria to attend school in the Neshaminy School	32	
33		District under the provisions of this policy shall be removed from school.	33
